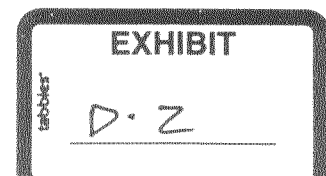
Dear Mr. Schafer:

This letter is to acknowledge service on July 5, 2000, 4:00 pm at the Court of Appeals, Division II, your subpoena for me to testify at your proceeding on July 17, 2000.

As you recall in our telephone conversation of July 5, 2000, I advised you I will be out of town and unavailable on that date and cannot appear personally at your proceeding.

In reviewing the paperwork attached to the subpoena and the statements contained in your Declaration, I can generally recall talking to you by telephone in February 1996. I can generally recall you asking about any preliminary or interim process the Supreme Court had for involving itself in judicial disciplinary matters. I can recall I told you there was no formal process and if you had questions about actions the Chief Justice had taken on certain cases, you contact the Chief Justice or the Commission on Judicial Conduct. The essence of my recollection and probable testimony would be consistent and limited to what is stated in this letter.

I also recall receiving from you, not only on this occasion but other occasions as well, materials on the Grant Anderson matter. I did not review the materials, have no recollection of the content of the materials, and personally recused myself on Judge Anderson's disciplinary proceeding before the Supreme Court.
